Calm-CalmView Version Compatibility

Although it is best to run the most up-to-date version of Calm and CalmView, users may wish to run a different one. In that case, it is important to be sure the version of Calm is compatible with the version of CalmView. The table below lists the versions of Calm that work best with each version of CalmView.

To run...	You must have...
CalmView 5.0	at least Calm 11.0
CalmView 4.0	at least Calm 11.0
CalmView 3.0	Calm 9.3, 10.0.1, or 10.0.2, but not Calm 10.0
CalmView 2.0-2.2	Calm 9.0 to Calm 10.0.2
DServe	Calm 9.3 or earlier

Checking Calm Version Numbers

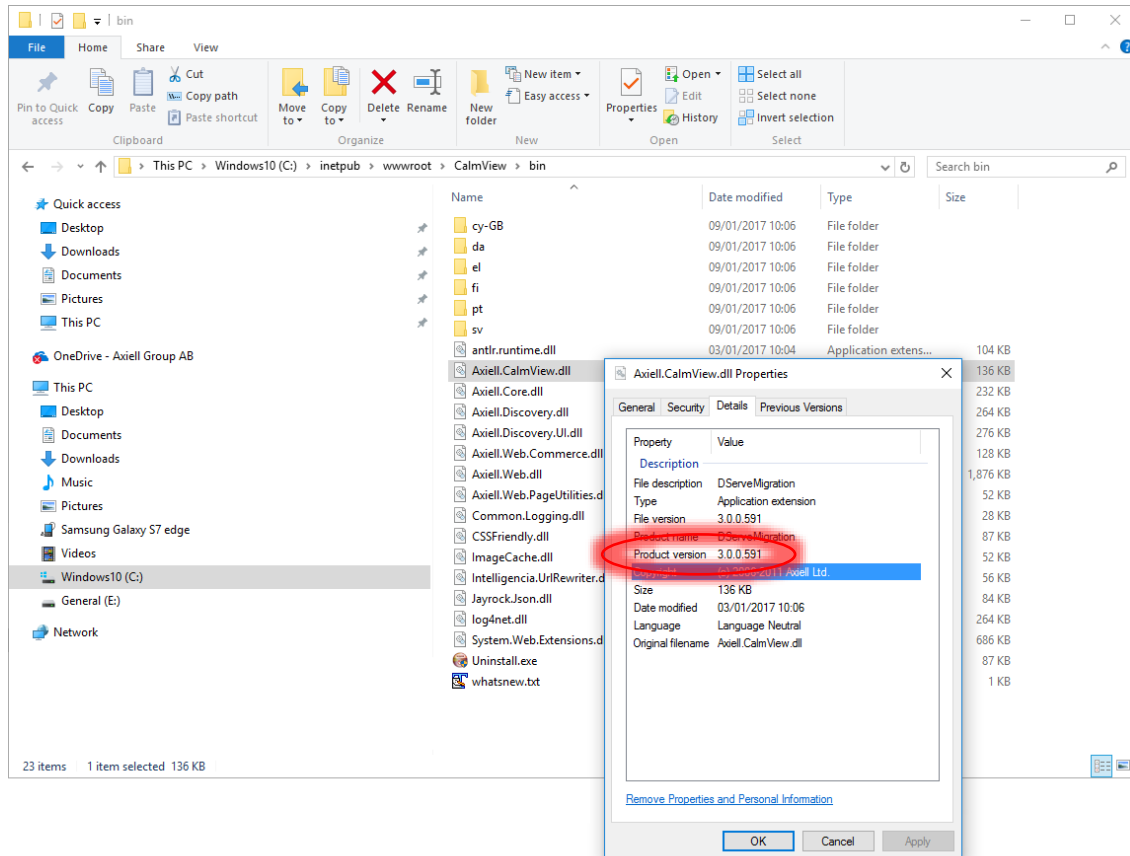
The main menu screen, under the Calm logo, contains the version number.



Checking CalmView Version Numbers

Once installed, there is nothing on the CalmView screens to indicate the version or the internal software build number. To check this, navigate on the web server to the `/inetpub/wwwroot/calmview/bin` folder, and right click on the file `axiell.calmview.dll` to view properties. On the details tab you will see the internal build version number.

Note that there are two versions of CalmView 5 in the downloads folder, one of them with (Responsive) in the name and the other not. CalmView 5 (Responsive) contains the new look and feel and other new features, whereas the non-responsive CalmView 5 is essentially CalmView 4 with the bug fixes and other tweaks that exist in CalmView 5.
